ORDINANCE NO. 95-04

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
PROPERTY BORDERING THE SOUTHEASTERN BOUNDARY
OF THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY
OF PLEASUREVILLE, KENTUCKY.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PLEASUREVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pleasureville Kentucky, having considered it to be in the best interest of the City to facilitate the growth and development of the community, and hereby declaring that it is desirable to annex the unincorporated territory more particularly described below, the Commission of the City of Pleasureville, Kentucky does hereby ordain as follows:

The City of Pleasureville does hereby annex the following tract of land described as follows:

A certain house and approximately 3/4 acre of ground situated on railroad Street in Pleasureville, Kentucky and located in Shelby County and bounded and described as follows: BEGINNING at a point in the center of the L&N Railroad and corner to the property of Mrs. Nannie D. Ellis; thence with said L&N Railroad in a westerly direction 137 feet to a point which is a newly established corner to another corner of W.H. Gordon; thence in a northern direction with new line of said W.H. Gordon (now Tom Curtis) 332 feet to a point corner to Gordon & Anderson Frazier; thence with Frazier 114 feet in a southeasterly direction to a point corner to the property of the said Nannie D. Ellis; thence with her line in a southernly direction 374 feet to the place of beginning, containing .77 of an acre, more or less.

BEING the same property as conveyed to Eugene Kelley and Hazel Kelley by deed dated April 12, 1978 and recorded in Deed Book 201, Page 178, in the office of the Shelby County Court Clerk.
