ORDINANCE NO. 14-96

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PRESTONSBURG, KENTUCKY ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY INTO THE CORPORATE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to annex certain property on U.S. 23, south of the current City limits, and;

WHEREAS, since the first reading of the ordinance, the remaining property owners petitioned the City to be annexed, and;

WHEREAS, the annexation is entirely voluntary and therefore the property owners do not require notice of the second reading or publication of the right to petition against annexation, and;

WHEREAS, the property to be annexed is contiguous to the boundaries of the City and is suitable for development for urban purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PRESTONS-BURG, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Prestonsburg hereby annexes into the municipal corporate limits, the property described in exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be published and the City map shall be amended to include this new annexed portion.

Section 3. All Ordinances, or any parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed to the extent of such conflict.
