

JUDGMENT

AT A COURT held March 3, 1958

This action coming on to be heard and it appearing to the Court from the record herein, that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in two issues of the Courier-Journal on February 8, 1958 and February 11, 1958, said newspaper being of general circulation and published in Jefferson County, Kentucky; and it further appearing to the Court, and the Court being sufficiently advised on the petition herein, that the population within the boundary described in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of the law in such cases, and no defense or objection having been made, it is now ordered, adjudged and decreed:

1. That a city by the name of "ROLLING FIELDS" be and the same is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class, within the following described boundary, as shown by the map filed with the petition herein, and more particularly described as follows:

"Beginning at a point in the Northeast corner of the intersection of Pennington Lane and Old Brownsboro Road; and running thence with the North line of Old Brownsboro Road North 50 degrees 47 minutes 30 seconds

East, 1328.66 feet to a point; thence running North 34 degrees 1 minute 30 seconds West, 2126.02 feet to a point in the South line of a tract owned by the Louisville Country Club Realty Company; thence South 53 degrees 09 minutes West, 498.83 feet; thence North 89 degrees 11 minutes West, 1141.67 feet; thence North 79 degrees 48 minutes West, 512.86 feet to another point in the line of property of the Louisville County Club Realty Company; thence South 47 degrees 14 minutes 30 seconds West, along a line of the Louisville Country Club Company's property, 721.40 feet to a point; thence South 34 degrees 00 minutes East, 2739.98 feet; thence North 70 degrees 5 minutes East, 1275.13 feet to a point in the East line of Pennington Lane; thence with the East line of Pennington Lane South 8 degrees 10 minutes East, 100 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; said property being all of the lots in Rolling Fields, Sections Numbered 1, 2, 3 and 4 except for lots Numbered 18 and 25 in Section Numbered 1 and lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 'A' in Section Numbered 2".

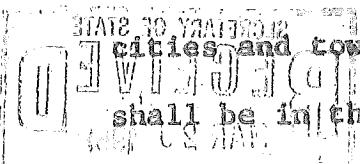
2. That there are hereby appointed as Board of Trustees of the said city of Rolling Fields, the following named persons, to-wit:

Each of the Trustees and Officers shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected. Qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law, by taking the prespective
