AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TERRITORY PREVIOUSLY WITHIN THE CITY OF FLATWOODS, KENTUCKY, ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT CITY OF RUSSELL, KENTUCKY

BE IT AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City of Russell, Kentucky, passed Ordinance No. 11 on September 2, 1980 which declared it desirable to annex that portion of the City of Flatwoods, described hereinbelow and directed that the question of annexation be submitted to the qualified voters of the portion of the City of Flatwoods described below at the next regular election; that at the next regular election held on November 4, 1980, a majority of those voting on the proposition favored annexation.

SECTION TWO: It is hereby ordained and declared that the portion of Flatwoods, Kentucky, described herein is annexed to the City of Russell and said annexed territory is described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of McCown Street S 33° 30' W 20 feet from the point where the City of Russell and the City of Flatwoods common boundary meet on Lot 15, Block C of Berkshire; thence N. 33° 30' E 442 feet following the present common boundary of the City of Russell and the City of Flatwoods; thence N. 56° 30' W. 823 feet to the center of Hamer Road; thence S 32° 26' W disecting Hamer Road 442 feet to the common intersection of the center line of Hamer Road and McCown Street; thence S 56° 30' E following the center line of McCown Street 815 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION THREE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and lawful publication.

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO ANNEX TO THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TERRITORY WITHIN THE CITY OF FLATWOODS, KENTUCKY, ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT CITY OF RUSSELL, KENTUCKY

BE IT AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City of Russell of Greenup County,

Kentucky, a City of the Fourth Class, proposes to annex to the City

of Russell the following described territory presently within the

City of Flatwoods, Kentucky:

Beginning at the center line of McCown Street S 33° 30' W 20 feet from the point where the City of Russell and the City of Flatwoods common boundary meet on Lot 15, Block C of Berkshire; thence N 33° 30' E 442 feet following the present common boundary of the City of Russell and the City of Flatwoods; thence N 56° 30' W 823 feet to the center of Hamer Road; thence S 32° 26' W disecting Hamer Road 442 feet to the common intersection of the center line of Hamer Road and McCown Street; thence S 56° 30' E following the center line of McCown Street 815 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION TWO: The City of Russell declares it desirable to annex that portion of the City of Flatwoods described above and directs that the question of annexation shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the portion of the City of Flatwoods described above at the next regular election.

SECTION THREE: It is hereby ordained that the Mayor of the City of Russell shall hereby certify this action to the Greenup County Clerk, who shall have printed on the ballots provided for use in that portion of the City of Flatwoods described above to be annexed, the question: "Are you in favor of annexing to the City of Russell, Kentucky?"


