The petition herein having been filed on September 10, 1976, and the Petitioner having filed Exhibit E showing that notice of the filing of said suit was published in The Courier Journal on October 4, 1976, and no objection or defense to the petition having been made or filed, and the Court being advised, it is adjudged that the following territory be and hereby is annexed to the City of St. Matthews, Kentucky, viz:

Beginning at a point in the westerly boundary line of the City of St. Matthews, which point is in the original westerly line of Breckinridge Lane, a 50-foot wide road as described in deed recorded in Deed Book 1243, page 469, in the office of the County Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky; said point being 883.82 feet southeast of the intersection of said westerly line with the center line of what was originally a private road, 20-feet wide, later widened and dedicated as a public road and now known as Hillsboro Road, and which point is the most northerly corner of parcel 265-B as described in deed to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, recorded in Deed Book 3917, page 286, in the aforesaid Clerk's office; thence southwardly with the present City boundary line and along the said original westerly line of Breckinridge Lane to its intersection with the present northerly line of Dutchmans Lane and the boundary line of the City of Louisville; thence westwardly along the present northerly line, southwardly along the present westerly line, westwardly along the present northerly line and northwardly along the present easterly line of Dutchmans Lane to a point in the western line of the F. M. Murphy tract as described in deed recorded in Deed Book 927, page 435 in the office of the aforesaid County Clerk; thence northwardly along the western line of the T. M. Murphy tract to a point in the southerly line of the McCoy tract as described in deed recorded in Deed Book 3886, page 43 in the aforesaid Clerk's office, and which is the present City boundary line; thence N 50° 27' 34" E 160 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe; thence along said boundary line S 78° 11' 59" E 103.62 feet, S 52° 11' 59" E 83.02 feet, S 68° 06' 59" E 124.08 feet, thence N 36° 03' 01" E 242.92 feet to an iron pipe in the northerly line of the right-of-way for Interstate Highway 64; thence along said right-of-way line N 85° 32' 30" E 570.90 feet, N 88° 44' 20" E 357.92 feet, and S 87° 27' 20" E 382 feet to the south-westerly corner of the aforementioned parcel 265-B; thence along the line of said parcel 265-B N 29° 50' 20" W 544.07 feet, and thence N 20° 51' 10" W 205 feet to the point of beginning.
