Plat is recorded in Deed Book 166, Page 639, in the office of the Jefferson County Clerk, Jefferson County, Kentucky; thence southeastwardly with the northeast line of said Lot 1 to the northwest line of a 33 foot road, as shown on said plat; thence southwestwardly with the northwest line of said 33 foot road and the straight extension southwestwardly thereof, 630 feet; thence northwestwardly and parallel with the northeast line of said Lot 1 to the center line of Westport Road; thence north-eastwardly with the center line of Westport Road 630 feet to the point of beginning.


