JUDGMENT OF ANNEXATION

* * * * *

Motion having been made by the City of St. Regis Park, and the petition for annexation having been filed herein on April 11, 1979, and the Petitioner having filed as Exhibit E an Affidavit of Publication showing that Notice of the petition or suit to annex was published in the Louisville Times on April 23, 1979, and on May 21, 1979, and no objection or defense to the annexation having been filed within 30 days of the filing of the petition and notice, or within the time fixed by order of this Court dated April 12, 1979, and the Court being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following territory be, and the same is hereby annexed to the City of St. Regis Park, viz:

Beginning at a point which is common to St. Regis Park Unit No. 2 as recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 10, Page 108; St. Regis Park Unit No. 3 as recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 10 Page 99; and Steeplechase Section No. 1 as recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 26 Page 60, all in the office of the Clerk of the Jefferson County Court; thence with the line of St. Regis Park Units Nos. 1 and 2 South 39 degrees 50 minutes 53 seconds East 420.75 feet to a point which is North 39 degrees 50 minutes 53 seconds West 22.00 feet from the most westerly corner of a tract conveyed to Annie L. Bullitt by instrument dated September 6, 1877, and recorded in Deed Book 210 Page 596, in the office of the Clerk of the Jefferson County Court, thence leaving said St. Regis line with a line 22.00 feet north of and parallel to the northwesterly line of said Bullitt tract North 50 degrees 33 minutes 55 seconds East 1,967.28 feet to a point; thence North 50 degrees 46 minutes 03 seconds West 905.34 feet to a point which is the most easterly corner of Steeplechase Section No. 2 as recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 27 Page 9, in the office of the Clerk of the Jefferson County Court; thence with the southeasterly line of said Steeplechase Section No. 2, South 37 degrees 32 minutes 17 seconds West 900.02 feet to an angle point in the line of Steeplechase Section No. 1, thence with the southeasterly line of Steeplechase Section No. 1 the following courses and distances: South 59 degrees 08 minutes 37 seconds West 244.23 feet to a point, thence South 32 degrees 26 minutes 40 seconds West 345.00 feet to a point; thence South 58 degrees 08 minutes 27 seconds West 335.00 feet to a point; thence South 50 degrees 08 minutes 27 seconds West 300.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 28.014 acres more or less.

And also being known as Steeplechase Subdivision, Section 5.


