**J U D G M E N T**

At a Court held on the 13th day of May, 1946.

This cause coming on to be heard, and it appearing to the Court from the record herein that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof have been published in two issues of The Louisville Times on April 26, 1946, and April 27, 1946, said newspaper being published in and of general circulation in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and it further appearing to the Court and the Court being satisfied from the verified petition herein that the population within the boundary described in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of law in such case, and no defense having been interposed herein, it is now ordered, adjudged, and decreed:

1. That a town by the name of SENECA VISTA be and is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class within the following described boundary as more fully shown by the plat filed with the petition herein, said boundary being described as follows, to wit:

"In Jefferson County, Kentucky, BEGINNING at a stone on the North side of Taylorsville Road, said stone being the southeast corner of lot No. "F" in Block "E", Seneca Vista Plat recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book No. 7, pages 118 and 119, filed on September 4, 1937, in the office of the County Clerk for Jefferson County, Kentucky. Thence with the north side of Taylorsville Road North 86-18 West, 366 feet to a stone on the north side of Taylorsville Road, said stone being on the west side of the right of way, 20 feet wide, referred to in deed from Paul Discher to William H. Fosdick dated January 7,

1869, and recorded in Deed Book No. 142, page 35, Jefferson County Clerk's office. Thence with the line of Edward Wetstein Estate and the west side of said right of way North 30-42-30 West 1530 feet to a stone corner on the west side of said right of way. This corner is common to the Edward Wetstein Estate and Adolph Reutlinger property and further described as being 20 feet westwardly from the northwest corner of Lot No. 1, Block "F" in said subdivision; thence with the line of the Adolph Reutlinger property North 55-26 East 671 feet to a stone on the west side of Seneca Park, near the intersection of Denham Road and Gladstone Avenue. Thence with the west side of Seneca Park South 34-10 East 2021 feet to the beginning corner, such area being a portion of acreage deeded to William F. Randolph by Joseph Discher dated December 31, 1925, and recorded in deed book 1194, page 206."

2. There are hereby appointed as the Board of Trustees of said town the following named persons who are residents therein, to wit:

Harrell N. Tague.


As the Police Judge, Williard Krapf; As the City Clerk, J. C. Wilcox; As the Marshall, Lyle Hoskins; As the Treasurer, Joe Hodge; As the Assessor, Lowell Armstrong; As the City Attorney, R. Bemis Lawrence. Each of such said trustees and officers shall hold their respective offices until the next general election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected and until such successors have been elected and qualified.

The qualifications of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law by taking the respective oaths of office and executing the respective bonds and obligations as may be prescribed by law, a record of which shall be entered upon the records of said town.
