## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE: The Shelbyville City Council finds that certain property owned by the Masonic Homes of Kentucky, Inc., and its affiliate the Masonic Home of Shelbyville, and more particularly described herein, is contiguous to the City of Shelbyville, and is suitable for use and development for urban purposes without unreasonable delay. The Shelbyville City Council further finds that said property is not included within the bounds of any other incorporated city, and that the owner of said property has executed a written consent to be annexed within the limits of the City of Shelbyville (Appendix A to this Ordinance), and that it is desirable that said property be annexed into the City of Shelbyville.

SECTION TWO: Based upon the aforementioned findings, there is hereby annexed to the City of Shelbyville, and its boundary line is extended so as to include within the limits of the City of Shelbyville, the property described as follows:

Property owned by the Masonic Homes of Kentucky, Inc., and its affiliate the Masonic Home of Shelbyville, which is more particularly described in the attached Appendix B to this Ordinance, which Appendix is incorporated by reference herein as if set forth in its entirety.

Introduced, seconded and given first reading at a duly convened meeting of the City Council of the City of Shelbyville on the 26th day of April, 2018.

Given a second reading and enacted at a duly convened meeting of the City Council of the City of Shelbyville on the 3rd day of May, 2018.
