This case coming on to be heard on the Petition of the City of Shively, Kentucky, a city of the Fourth Class, and it appearing that less than a majority of the resident voters of the area proposed to be annexed have remonstrated against said annexation, and upon hearing of the issues herein involved:

- (1) That annexation will be for the interest of the City of Shively and
- (2) That annexation will cause no material injury to the owners of real estate in the area proposed to be annexed, and the Court finding that all the requirements of KRS 81.210 and 81.220 applicable to said annexation have been complied with and further finding that the proposed annexation will be for the interest of the City of Shively and that it will cause no material injury to the owners of real estate; Now, therefore, It is ordered and adjudged as follows:


1. That the proposed annexation by the City of Shively, Kentucky, of the tract of land hereinafter described be, and the same is hereby approved by the Court as an annexation to the corporate limits of the City of Shively, Kentucky and that the city boundary of said city may, by appropriate ordinance, be extended to include therein the following tract of land which is the subject of this annexation

proceeding:

Tract #1. BEGINNING at a point in the present West boundary line of the City of Shively, Kentucky, said point being South of Mercer Avenue and West of Ronda Drive and being in the Northeast right of way line of Interstate Highway I-264 of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, said point being 130.00 feet right of center line Station 158 + 15 <sup>97</sup>, thence with said right of way line North and West to a point in the present boundary line of the City of Shively, Kentucky, said point being South 03 degrees 42 minutes 20 seconds West 160.00 feet from the center line of Garrs Lane and being 110.86 feet right of Highway I-264 center line Station 168 + 35 <sup>92</sup>, thence with the existing boundary line of the City of Shively South 86 degrees 38 minutes 56 seconds East and South 03 degrees 51 minutes 15 seconds West to the point of beginning.

Tract #2. BEGINNING at a point in the present boundary line of the City of Shively, Kentucky, said point being in the vicinity of Moray Court, said point being also in the Southeast right of way line of Interstate I-264, South 85 degrees 36 minutes 02 seconds East, 110.00 feet from center line Station of Highway I-264 176 + 85 <sup>90</sup>, thence with the East and Southeast right of way lines of Highway I-264, Northeast to a point in the present boundary line of the City of Shively, Kentucky, said point being also in the East right of way line of Highway I-264 and the North right of way line of Huber Road, said point being South 86 degrees 27 minutes 55 seconds East 121.01 feet from Highway I-264 center line Station 216 + 07 <sup>30</sup>, thence with the present Western boundary line of the City of Shively, Kentucky, East, Southwest and West to the point of beginning.


2. That the clerk of this Court shall forward a certified copy of this Judgment to the City Council of the City of Shively, Kentucky to be entered upon the records of said legislative body.
