JUDGMENT

At a Court held on the 14th of April, 1950.

This cause coming on to be heard, and it appearing to the Court from the records herein that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in two issues of the Louisville Times, on March 22, 1950 and March 29, 1950, said newspaper being published in and of general circulation in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and it further appearing to the Court and the Court being satisfied from the verified petition herein that the population within the boundary described in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of law in such cases, and no defense having been imposed herein, it is now ordered, adjudged and decreed:

1. That a town by the name of Springlee be and is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class within the following described boundary, as more fully described and shown by a map filed with the petition herein, said boundary being described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the southwest line of Browns Lane at a point in the southeast line of a tract of land conveyed to Miller and Florine Prentice by deed in Deed Book 1772, page 386 and recorded March 1941, and further identified as Tract No. 63, Map 28, Jefferson County Tax Commissioner's Office; thence

southwestwardly with the southeast line of the Miller tract and the southeast line of Spring Hill Subdivision Section #5, recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 9, page 66, and the southeast line of Springhill Subdivision Section #4, recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 8, page 78, a distance of 1759.73 feet to the southeast line of Breckinridge Lane at the southwest corner of Subdivision Lot 1, Block "C" in Springhill Subdivision Section #4, thence with the southeast line of Breckinridge Lane northwestwardly a distance of 1263.08 feet to the northwest corner of Subdivision Lot #1, Block "A" in Springhill Subdivision Section #1, recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 7, page 127, thence northeastwardly with the northwest line of Springhill Subdivision Section #1, recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 7, page 127 to a point in the southwest line of Browns Lane, a distance of 1758.30 feet at the northeast corner of Subdivision Lot #6, Block "C" Springhill Subdivision Section #1, thence southeastwardly with the northwest line of Browns Lane a distance of 1263.08 feet to the point of beginning:

2. That there are hereby appointed as the Board of Trustees of said town the following named persons resident therein, towit, Robert C. Fritz, Olan J. Hill, Henry Mashburn, Charles E. Payne, Deitsell Bement; Robert A. Livingston as Police Judge thereof, Fred L. Hassenpflug as Marshall thereof, and Mrs. Doris S. Bush as Assessor thereof. Each of said Trustees and officers

shall hold their respective offices until the next General election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected and until their successors shall have been elected and qualified.

The qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law and by taking the respective oaths of office and executing the respective bonds and obligations prescribed by law which shall be entered upon the records of said town.

In accordance with Section 81.060, KRS, The Clerk of this Court is directed, not later than ten (10) days after the entry of this judgment, to certify a copy thereof to the Secretary of State at Frankfort, Kentucky.
