JUDGMENT

At a Court held on the 16th day of January, 1946.

This cause coming on to be heard and it appearing to the Court from the record herein that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in the issues of the Louisville Times on December 3, 1945, on December 4, 1945, and on December 11, 1945, said newspaper being of general circulation and published in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and it further appearing to the Court and the Court being satisfied from the verified petition herein that the population within the boundaries is sufficient to meet the requirements of law in such cases and no defense having been interposed herein, it is now ordered, adjudged and decreed:

1. That a town by the name of STRATHMOOR GARDENS be, and the same is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class within the following boundary as shown by the map filed with the petition herein, to-wit and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the Southwestwardly corner of the Sub-division of Strathmoor Addition and Bardstown Road, as shown on Plat and Sub-division Book 4, Pages 40 and 41 in the Office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky, and thence with the line common to the town of Strathmoor Village and Strathmoor Addition North 55 degrees 50 minutes East 1331.42 feet to the Southwesterly line of the town of Kingsley; thence South 34 degrees 10 minutes East, along the line common to Kingsley and Strathmoor Addition 518.38 feet to a stone in the tract of land owned by A. B. Driesbach and corner to the town of Kingsley; thence North 55½ degrees East with the line of Kingsley 24.25 feet to an iron pipe in the Northeasterly line of the tract conveyed to A. B. Driesbach by deed recorded in Deed Book 1999 Page 286; thence South 34 degrees 21 minutes East 159.42 feet along said Northeasterly line to an iron pipe, thence South 55 degrees 39 minutes West along a line parallel with Gladstone Avenue 197.17 feet to an iron pipe in the corner common to lots 90 and 109 on the line of lot 132 of Strathmoor Addition; thence South 34 degrees 21 minutes East 403.19 feet with the line of lot 132 common to lots 109 and 120 to an iron pipe in the Westerly line of an 18 foot alley; thence South 55 degrees 39 minutes West along the Westerly line of said alley 910.51 feet to the Bardstown Road; thence Northwestwardly along the line common to Bardstown Road and Strathmoor Addition 1108.43 feet to the beginning, and containing 28.6 acres and being the same property conveyed to Consolidated Realty Company by deed recorded in Deed Book 1022 page 189 and tract conveyed to A. B. Driesbach by deed in Deed Book 1999 page 286 and part of tract conveyed to A. J. Driesbach et al by deed recorded in Deed Book 1932 page 47. All books are of record in the office of the Clerk of

the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky.

2. There are hereby appointed as Board of Trustees of said town the following named persons, residents therein, to-wit:

E. M. Murphy,

F. S. Cogswell,

C. M. Spencer,

As Police Judge thereof Charles G. Kipp; as Marshall thereof J. P. Doll; as Assessor thereof J. L. Brown; each of said Trustee and Officer shall hold his respective office until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected. The qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law by taking the respective oath of office and executing respective bonds and obligations as may be prescribed by law, a record of which shall be entered upon the records of said town and copies thereof certified.

3. The Clerk of this Court is directed in not later than ten days, to certify a copy of this judgment to the Secretary of State of Kentucky as provided by Statute.
