JUDGMENT

The cause herein being submitted for judgment and it appearing to the Court that a petition has been filed herein; that more than two-thirds (2/3) of the voters residing within the boundaries of the area and territory hereinafter described as the area and territory proposed to be incorporated have signed the petition to incorporate said area and territory; that more than one hundred and twenty-five (125) inhabitants reside therein; that the petition to incorporate said area and territory has been duly advertised as required by law; that no objections have been filed against said petition to incorporate; and the Court being sufficiently advised in the matter.

It is therefore Ordered and Adjudged that the area and territory hereinafter described be and the same is hereby incorporated as a municipal corporation of the Sixth (6th) Class to be named and hereafter known as the City of Summit Hills Heights and more particularly described by notes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at the point in the center line of Dudley Road where the dividing line between the Summit Hills Heights and the Hatfield land intersects said center line; thence with said dividing line S 45°00' E, 1260 feet to a point; thence N 30°00' E, 257 feet to a point; thence S 45°00' E, 660 feet, more or less, to a corner of the Sellers tract now a portion of Summit Hills Heights; thence N 42° 21' E, 610 feet to a point; thence S 50° 59' E, 1780 feet to a point; thence S 86°16' W, 48 feet to a point; thence N 44° 00' E, 798 feet to a point; thence S 5° 00' E, 720 feet more or less, to a point in the north line of Section 12 of Summit Hills Heights; thence with the north line of Section 12, S 86° 59' E, 390 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of Lot 5 in Section 12; thence with the east line of Section 12, S 1° 01' W, 471.74 feet to a point in the south line of Section 12; thence with the south line of Section 12, N 65° 30' W, 547 feet to a point; thence S 5° 00' E, 780 feet to a point; thence N 36° 45' W, 1675 feet to a point; thence N 34° 15' W, 1050 feet, more or less, to a point in the extension of the South line of the Norman J. Arlinghaus tract; thence with the extension of the south line of the said Arlinghaus tract S 43° 24' W, 468 feet, more or less, to the southwest corner of said Arlinghaus tract; thence with the west line of said tract N 46° 46' W, 2476.36 feet to a point in the center line of Dudley Road; thence northeastwardly with the center line of Dudley Road, 1220 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.


The Court, being further advised that the petitioners agreed upon the persons who are to serve as officers of said City, herewith designates and appoints the following persons to serve as Trustees of the City of Summit Hills Heights, viz., FRED FETFIG, WALTER J. MOELLERING, CLARENCE RICE, JOSEPH T. MOLONEY and GEORGE W. COOK.

The Court further designates and appoints:

GEORGE WEIDNER to serve as Police Judge,  
CARL FOLEZ, JR. to serve as Marshall, and  
CLYDE J. GILMORE to serve as Assessor.

of said City of Summit Hills Heights. It is further Ordered and Adjudged that said Trustees, Police Judge, Marshall and Assessor shall serve in their respective capacities as provided by law until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

It is further Ordered and Adjudged that the Clerk of this Court be and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this judgment to the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
