TITLE: ANNEXATION OF BOARD OF EDUCATION PROPERTY.

SECTION ONE: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance that is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, then, such portion, or portions, shall be deemed as separate, distinct and independent provisions and such holdings shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION TWO: Any previous ordinance or resolution in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall become effective after passage, approval and publication as required by the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and other appropriate law.

SECTION FOUR: THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TOMPKINSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Tompkinsville having heretofore announced its intention to annex that property formerly known as the Kathleen Carter farm purchased by the Monroe County Board of Education by deed dated October 25, 1988, and recorded in Deed Book 64, page 3, records Monroe County Clerk's Office, as attached to the previous ordinance that announced said intention, and said ordinance being properly enacted and published, the City of Tompkinsville hereby consummates said annexation 60 days from publication having elapsed.
