JUDGEMENT

This matter having come on the petition of 81 inhabitants of the area proposed to be incorporated for a judgment establishing the City of Union, Kentucky, and it appearing to the court that the petitioners have met all of the jurisdictional requirements for these proceedings, and the court being sufficiently advised,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS CONSIDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, and by these presents this court does hereby establish the City of Union, Kentucky, and the boundaries of said city are established as follows:

The center of the boundary to be hereinafter described lies approximately 5 mile South-West of the City of Florence in Boone County, Kentucky, and the said center of said boundary lies at 84 degrees, 40 minutes and 48 seconds West longitude and 38 degrees, 57 minutes and 5 seconds North latitude. The limits of said boundary are one half mile NorthWest and SouthEast of said center and one half mile NorthEast and SouthEast of said center. Said boundary is described more particularly by metes and bounds as follows;

BEGINNING at a point on the West shoulder of U.S. Highway #42 which is 30 feet S 35 degrees E from the SouthEast corner of the oil service Station building located on the property now or formerly owned by Clinton Jones; thence from said point of beginning S 31-55 W 5280 feet to a point in the property now or formerly owned by Muncy; thence S 58-5 E crossing the Union-Big Bone Road at approximately 2850 feet; a total distance of 5280 feet to a point in the SouthWest edge of the pavement of U.S. Highway #42 opposite an old farm road; thence N 31-55 E crossing the Union-Mt. Zion Road at Approximately 2900 feet, a total distance of 5280 feet; thence N 58-5 W 5280 feet to the place of beginning containing 640 acres.
