CHAPTER 116

(H. B. 439)

AN ACT changing the classification of the city of Vanceburg, in Lewis County.

WHEREAS, satisfactory evidence has been presented to the General Assembly that the population of the city of Vanceburg, in Lewis County, is such as to justify its being assigned to the fourth class of cities;

NOW THEREFORE

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

The city of Vanceburg, in Lewis County, is changed from the fifth class to the fourth class of cities.

CHAPTER 117

(H. B. 441)

AN ACT providing that in any county having a population of less than 75,000, in which the county clerk shall have had his official bond executed by an incorporated surety company, the amount paid by such clerk as premium on such bond shall not be computed as part of the net compensation which he receives or retains for his services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

In any county having a population of less than 75,000, in which the county clerk shall have had his official bond executed by an incorporated surety company, the amount paid by such clerk as premium on such bond shall not be computed as part of the net compensation which he receives or retains for his services but shall be considered as office expense payable out of the gross receipts of such clerk's office before any such computation of his net compensation.

WHEREAS, each municipality of this state must furnish the following information and exhibits to the Secretary of State, on or before July 1, 1981,

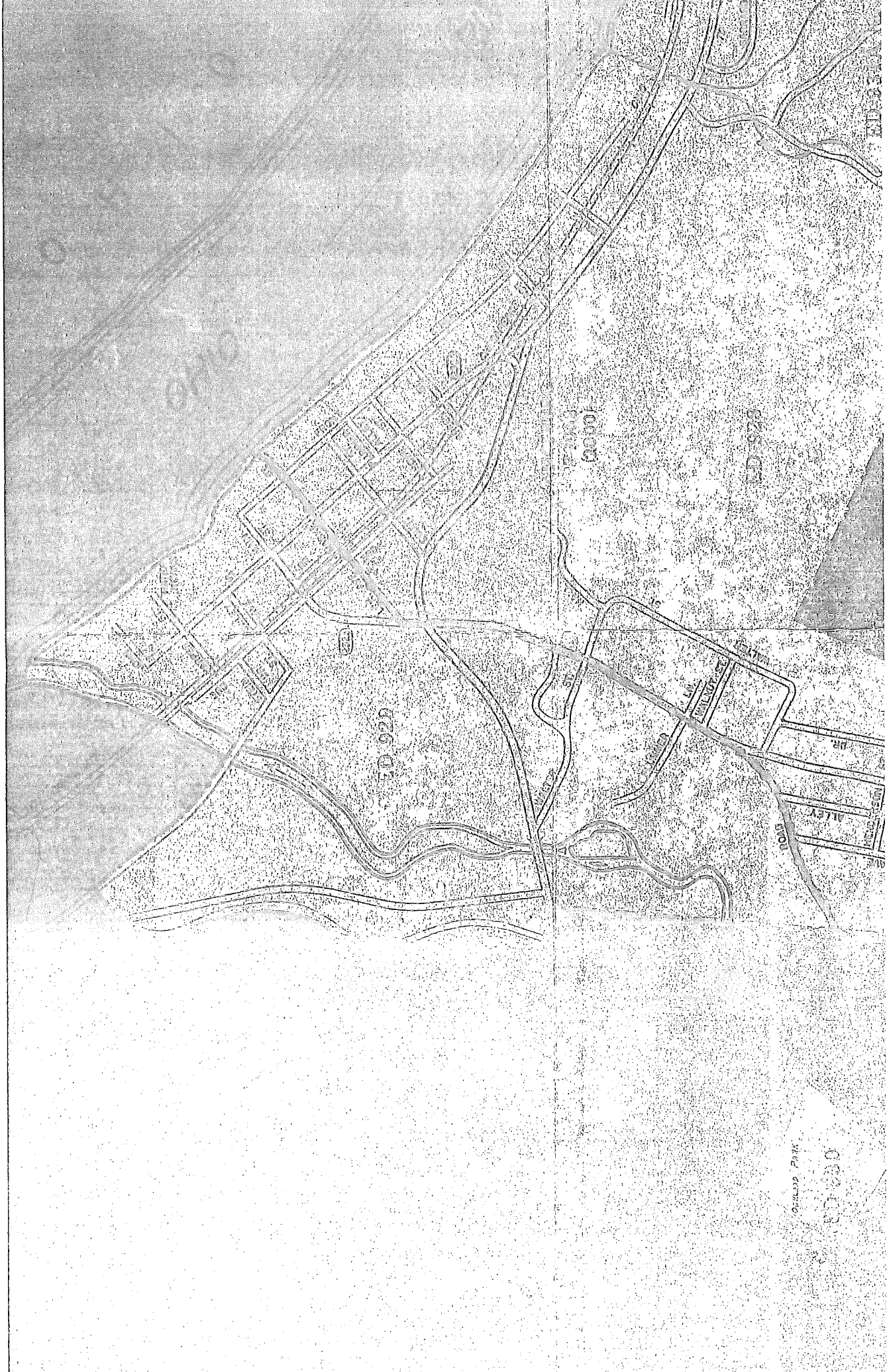

1. The name of the City is Vanceburg, Kentucky.
2. The City of Vanceburg was incorporated by act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky by Act dated January 24, 1827, and of record in Kentucky Acts, 1826-27, Chapter 101, pages 121.
3. The present classification of the City of Vanceburg is as a City of the 4th Class.
4. The present boundaries of the City are as described in the attached exhibits.
