

ORDINANCE NO. 27, Series 1983

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF WATTERSON PARK A PORTION OF THE CITY OF POPLAR HILLS IN THE COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, BETWEEN THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE SOUTHERN RAILROAD AND THE SOUTHWEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF NEWBURG ROAD; AND BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST LINE OF POPLAR LEVEL ROAD AND THE NORTHWEST LINE OF EAST INDIAN TRAIL AND BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST LINE OF JENNINGS LANE TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTHWEST LINE OF PRODUCE ROAD, AND THE EXTENDED NORTHEAST BOUNDARY LINE OF A TRACT CONVEYED TO THE GEORGIA INDUSTRIAL REALTY COMPANY BY DEED OF RECORD IN DEED BOOK 3199, PAGE 113, AND BETWEEN THE NORTHWEST LINE OF PRODUCE ROAD, THE SAID AREA BEING MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WATTERSON PARK:

Section 1. It is deemed desirable and it is hereby annexed to the City of Watterson Park and the boundaries of the City of Watterson Park are hereby extended to include that certain tract of real property which is now a portion of the City of Poplar Hills and which is embraced within the County of Jefferson and which is adjacent to and contiguous with the present City of Watterson Park boundary line and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline of Poplar Level Road with the centerline of Indian Trail; then Northwest with the centerline of Poplar Level Road 3450 feet + to its intersection with the centerline of Produce Road; thence with the centerline of Produce Road in a Northeasterly direction 3260 feet + to its intersection with the centerline of Jennings Lane; thence with the centerline of Jennings Lane in a Northwesterly direction 2650 feet + to its intersection

with the Southerly right-of-way line of the Southern Railroad said point being also in the southerly corporate limit line of the City of Watterson Park; thence with the Southerly line of the Southern Railroad and with said corporate limit line of the City of Watterson park in an Easterly direction, 3740 feet + to its intersection with the Northerly line of Produce Road; thence in a Southerly direction 80 feet + to the Southerly line of Produce Road; thence along said right-of-way line of Produce Road in a westerly direction 26 feet + to a P.C. of a curve; thence along said curve to the left having a radius of 769 feet +, 338 feet + to the P.T. of the curve; thence continuing with said south right-of-way line of Produce Road in a westerly direction, 740 feet + to a point at the northwest corner of tract 1-D of U.R. Project No. R-69, Section 1 as recorded in Plat Book 30, Page 79, in the Office of the Jefferson County Court Clerk; thence along the westerly line of said tract 1-D in a southerly direction 834 feet + to the northerly line of Abernathy Road; thence along said northerly line of Abernathy Road 793.18 feet + in a southwesterly direction to a point, said point also being on the northerly line of Abernathy Road; thence continuing 584 feet + southwesterly on said northerly line of Abernathy Road extended to its intersection with the northeasterly line of a tract conveyed to the Georgia Industrial Realty Company by deed of record in Deed Book 3199, Page 113; thence southwesterly with said northeasterly line of said tract extended to its point of intersection with the centerline of Indian Trail; thence southeast along the centerline of Indian Trail 3408 feet + to the point of the beginning, containing 386 feet + acres.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish and advertise this ordinance as required by Chapter 424 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes upon its passage and approval.
