-JUDGMENT-

This cause coming on to be heard and it appearing to the court from the record herein that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in two issues of the Louisville Times on April 19, 1946 and on April 20, 1946, said newspaper being of general circulation and published in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and it further appearing to the court and the court being satisfied from the verified petition herein that the population within the boundaries is sufficient to meet the requirements of law in such cases, and no defense having been interposed herein, it is now ordered, adjudged and decreed:

1. That a town by the name of "WELLINGTON" be, and the same is, hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class within the following described boundary, as shown by the map filed with the petition herein, to-wit, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone in the northeasterly line of the Bardstown Road at the intersection with the northwesterly line of Wellington, extension of Stratmoor; said stone being also corner to Lot #1 as shown on Plan of said

Wellington extension of Strathmoor of record in Plat and Subdivision Book #6, pages 34, 35 and 36 in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky; thence with said lien of said Bardstown Road south 34 degrees 03 minutes east 1162.63 feet to the intersection with the easterly line of Wendell Avenue as shown on said plan and also corner to the tract of land containing 5.18 acres more or less conveyed by A. M. Anderson to Major Taylor by Deed dated November 25, 1935, and recorded in Deed Book 1689, page 187 in the office aforesaid; thence northeastwardly with a line of said tract and also with a line of said Wendell Avenue, with a curve to the right said curve having a radius of 25 feet, 39.69 feet; thence continuing with the line of said 5.18 acre tract and with the southeasterly line of Wendell Avenue as shown on said Plan with a curve to the right, the chords of which are as follows: north 56 degrees 34 minutes east 72.58 feet, north 58 degrees 28 minutes east 100 feet, north 60 degrees 27 minutes east 100 feet; thence continuing with said line of Wendell Avenue with a curve to the left the chords of which are as follows: north 58 degrees 23 minutes east 100 feet, north 52 degrees 59 minutes east 100 feet, north 47 degrees 37 minutes east 100 feet, north 42 degrees 20 minutes east 100 feet, north 35 degrees 31 minutes east 40.38 feet; thence in an easterly direction with a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 21.86 feet, 50.65 feet to a point in the southwesterly line of Lowell Avenue, as shown on said plan of Wellington and also corner to the 5.18 acre tract above referred to; thence with a line of said tract and with the southwesterly line of Lowell Avenue south 18 degrees 20 minutes east, 41.27 feet to an iron pipe corner to same and also corner to said Wellington extension of Strathmoor above referred to; thence with said line which is the terminus of said Lowell Avenue and the southeasterly line of Lot #289 as shown on plan of said Wellington north 70 degrees 13 minutes east 217.08 feet to an iron pipe corner to said Wellington and in the southwesterly line of the Joe Bischoff tract; thence with a line common to said Wellington and Bischoff tract north 15 degrees 17 minutes west 408 feet to a stone corner to same; thence with the southeasterly line of Wellington extension of Strathmoor and in part with line of said Bischoff tract north 55 degrees 32 minutes east 1746.62 feet to the southwesterly line of Bon Air Avenue; thence with said line of Bon Air Avenue north 33 degrees 11 minutes west 640.23 feet to an iron pipe at the northeasterly corner of Lot #210 as shown on said plan of Wellington; thence with the northwesterly line of said Wellington extension of Strathmoor, south 55 degrees 32 minutes west 1219.85 feet to a corner of same; thence with another line of Wellington north 33 degrees 49 minutes west 220.68 feet to the northeasterly corner of Lot #154 as shown on said plan and in the southeasterly line of Clarendon Avenue; thence with said lien of Clarendon Avenue which is the northwesterly line of Wellington south 55 degrees 09 minutes west 186.14 feet to another corner of Wellington and in the southwesterly line of Spencer Avenue; thence with said last mentioned line south 34 degrees 48 minutes east 12.42 feet to another corner of said Wellington and at the northeasterly corner of Lot #118 as shown on aforesaid plan; thence with the northwesterly line of said Wellington south 55 degrees 20 minutes west 1445.66 feet to the beginning.

As more particularly described in Plat and Subdivision Book #6, pages 34, 35 and 36 in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky.

2. There are hereby appointed as the Board of Trustees of said Town the following named persons, residents therein, to-wit:

William D. Broeman
James K. Gloster
Orris Reynolds, Jr.
F. E. Mudd

As Police Judge thereof, Lee E. Riedling; as Marshal thereof, William E. Leatherman; as an Assessor thereof, Louis F. Deibel; each of which said trustees and officers shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected. The qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law by taking the respective oaths of office and executing respective bonds and obligations as may be prescribed by law, a record of which shall be entered upon the records of said town and copies thereof certified.
