ORDINANCE NO. 94-_____

AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF WHITE PLAINS,
KENTUCKY TO ANNEX ADJOINING TERRITORY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WHITE PLAINS,
KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City of White Plains, Kentucky, pursuant to KRS 81A.400, et seq., hereby states its intent to annex certain real property, which property is more particularly described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. A map of the territory proposed for annexation is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of White Plains and it is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.


Section 2: The unincorporated territory proposed for annexation is adjacent or contiguous to the boundaries of the City of White Plains. The real property proposed for annexation by virtue of population density, commercial, industrial, institutional or governmental use of land, or subdivision of land is urban in character or suitable for development for urban purposes without unreasonable delay. No part of the area proposed for annexation is included within the boundary of another incorporated city.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.



RED HILL WHITFIELD SCHOOL HOUSE ROAD, ORTEN BRIDGE ROAD & CLAUD
YOUNG ROAD

Beginning at the present city limits 300 feet South of Hardwick Road due south along the East edge of Red Hill Whitfield School House Road to Orten Bridge Road due East along the North edge of Orten Bridge Road to the West edge of Claude Young Road the due Northeast along the West edge of Claude Young Road to the West edge of State Road 813, then due North along the West edge of State Road 813 to the present City Limits 300 feet Southeast of Hardwick Road. All land enclosed in this area is to be annexed.
