ORDINANCE NO. 558

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY AS A PART OF THE CITY OF WICKLIFFE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, IT IS HEREBY DEEMED TO BE TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND WELFARE OF THE CITY OF WICKLIFFE, KY, AND THE TERRITORY PROPOSED TO BE ANNEXED, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICKLIFFE, KENTUCKY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Therefore, since the City of Wickliffe has obtained prior agreement from Hillhouse Natural Farms (Batts), Ronald Harrison (Wickliffe Skid Co.), 96 Classic Country and Wickliffe Rental Properties Inc. (Kelley), Pace Local 5-0680 (Union Hall), Ballard County Fiscal Court and the Wickliffe Masonic Lodge #625; the City hereby annexes these properties east of the current City boundaries and along Route 286 towards Paducah up to Buck Road(See description of the full boundary area approximately).

The purpose for the annexation is multi:

1. Further development of the Industrial Park.
2. Service this area with city water, sewerage and fire protection.
3. Future development of commercial and possible residential homes because of city services.
4. Establish the City limits in a direction that can better place the community in a position for future growth.

A detailed discription of the properties to be annexed into the City limits and a detailed map are attached.

This ordinance shall become effective after its publication. First reading on July 6, 2004 and passed at its second reading on August 1, 2004.

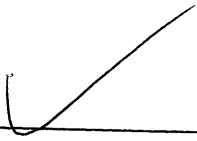

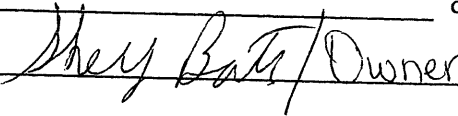
