Comes now petitioner, a municipal corporation of the fourth class and for its cause of action herein states:

(1) On the 14th day of September, 1971, the said petitioner approved an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Annexing Certain Territory To The City Of Williamsburg, Kentucky," which said ordinance annexes certain territory therein described to the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky. A certified copy of said ordinance is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if copied herein in full and marked "Exhibit A".


(2) Petitioner states that said ordinance was passed by the Council of the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky, on the 14th day of September, 1971, approved by the Mayor on the same day and was printed in the Whitley Republican, the newspaper qualified for this municipal area under the provisions of KRS 424.120 (1) for three consecutive weeks, to-wit: September 23, 1971, September 30, 1971, and October 7, 1971.

(3) Petitioner states that the land embraced by said annexation surrounds the existing corporate limits of the City and that the purpose

of said annexation is to provide the additional territory with City services, and petitioner states that it will be in the best interest of the City of Williamsburg and the present and future owners of the area projected to be annexed for the said annexation to be approved. A map showing the present corporate limits of the City and the area prayed to be annexed is attached to this Petition as "Exhibit B".

(4) Petitioner states that this is an action under the provisions of KRS 81.210.

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays that the Court enter a judgment annexing the hereinabove described territory to the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky.

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Comes now petitioner, a municipal corporation of the fourth class and for its amended cause of action herein states:

(1) It adopts and reiterates all the allegations of the original petition except as set out below.

(2) At a special meeting of the Williamsburg City Council held on October 26, 1971, and a quorum being present, and resolution was duly enacted directing the Mayor to employ a surveyor to delete the Beck's Creek area from the territory proposed to be annexed and directing the City's attorney to amend this action accordingly. That this action was with the concurrence of and at the request of the property owners in the area proposed to be deleted herefrom. A legal description of the area proposed to be deleted is annexed to this amended petition as "Exhibit C" and fully incorporated by reference.


(3) Petitioner states that there is annexed to this amended petition as "Exhibit D" a legal description of the proposed corporate limits of the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky, as same will exist if this Court approves ordinance #288 as amended by this amended petition. This description is fully incorporated into the amended petition by reference, the same as if copied in full herein.

(4) Petitioner states that it will be in the best interest of the City of Williamsburg and the present and future owners of the area proposed to be annexed for this annexation to be approved, as amended. A map showing the

proposed corporate limits is attached to this amended petition as "Exhibit E".

(5) Petitioner states that this amended petition is filed without notice prior to answer pursuant to the provisions of CR 15.01.

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays that the Court enter a judgment annexing the hereinabove described territory to the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky.



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for three consecutive weeks, to-wit: September 23, 1971; September 30, 1971; and October 7, 1971, in the Whitley Republican, a newspaper of general circulation in Williamsburg, Kentucky, and meeting the requirements of Chapter 424 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

(3) The Petition herein was filed on September 27, 1971. Due notice of the filing of the Petition herein was given by publication in the Whitley Republican on September 30, 1971, October 7, 1971, and October 14, 1971.

(4) An Amended Petition deleting certain of the proposed territory was properly filed without notice pursuant to CR 15.01 on December 7, 1971.

(5) No protest to the proposed annexation has been filed.

(6) A legal description of the territory proposed to be annexed is attached to this Judgment as "Exhibit A" and fully incorporated by reference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the aforesaid ordinance of the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky, is approved and the territory described therein, as amended, is hereby annexed to the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky. The City of Williamsburg, Kentucky, is hereby authorized to enter the Judgment upon its records and thereafter shall, by ordinance, annex the aforesaid territory to the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky.
