ORDINANCE NO. 1996-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN, KENTUCKY
ANNEXING INTO THE CITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN, KENTUCKY
CERTAIN TERRITORY WHICH IS GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS
"THE CEMETERY ON THE DRY RIDGE," AS HEREINAFTER
DESCRIBED, AND AS SET FORTH IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED
HERETO.

WHEREAS, the City of Williamstown, by and through its City Council proposed to annex certain territory into its corporate city limits, certain territory which is referred to as the "Cemetery on the Dry Ridge;" and

WHEREAS, the City of Williamstown, by and through its City Council passed Ordinance No. 1995-18 proposing to annex said territory in accordance with K.R.S. 81A-420 and K.R.S. 81A.410, with a first reading on September 5, 1995, second reading on October 2, 1995, with said Ordinance being published in The Grant County News on October 12, 1995; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Notice and publication sixty (6) days have elapsed with no Petition in Opposition being lodged by resident voters or owners of real property within the proposed territory to be annexed to the Mayor, Williamstown City Building, 400 North Main Street, P.O. Box 147, Williamstown, KY 41097-0147;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

By and through this ordinance, the City of Williamstown, Kentucky annexes into the corporate city limits, certain territory which is referred to as the "Cemetery on the Dry Ridge" and is more particularly described as:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the cemetery property as recorded in Deed Book A, Pages 10 and 11 said point being at the northeast corner of H. Branson Lot as recorded in Plat Book 1, Pages 108 and 109 and the line of A. Milner as recorded in Deed Book 94, Page 521 said point being 54.3' from the rightway line of US 25. From said point following the south property line of Miller E 78° 94' to the line of Donald Conrad as recorded in Deed Book 88, Page 639. Following the line of Donald Conrad E 78° 130' to a corner from said corner S 200° 213' to the right away line of Conrad Lane. Along said right away 267° W 50' to the corner of Conrad Lane, H. Branson and cemetery lot N 330° 193' to the point of beginning.

and as further set forth in the diagram attached hereto as Exhibit "A" which is incorporated by

reference.

In accordance with K.R.S. 81A.420(1) the Williamstown City Council hereby verifies the availability of said territory for annexed pursuant to one or more of the criteria as set forth in K.R.S. 81A.410.

SECTION II

There is excluded here from any area already in any incorporated city, including, but not necessarily limited to the City of Williamstown, Kentucky.

SECTION III

Notice was hereby given that within sixty (60) days after enactment of Ordinance 1995-18 proposing to annex the incorporated territory herein to the City of Williamstown, Kentucky, one or more resident voters or owners of real property within the territory proposed to be annexed may petition the Mayor in Opposition to the proposed annexation. Any such petition was to be returned to the Williamstown City Building, 400 North Main Street, P.O. Box 147, Williamstown, Kentucky 41097-0147. No objection or petitions have been filed or lodged with the Mayor's office, City of Williamstown, Kentucky

SECTION IV

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

SECTION V

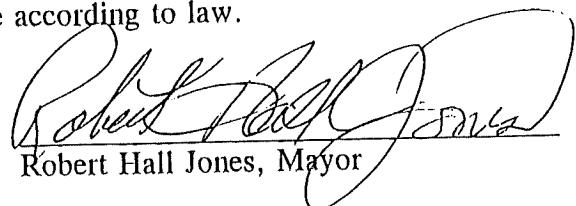
All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION VI

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

SECTION VII

This ordinance shall be published in full pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060(9) and K.R.S. 100.207 and shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

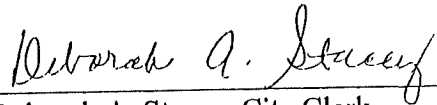
CERTIFICATION

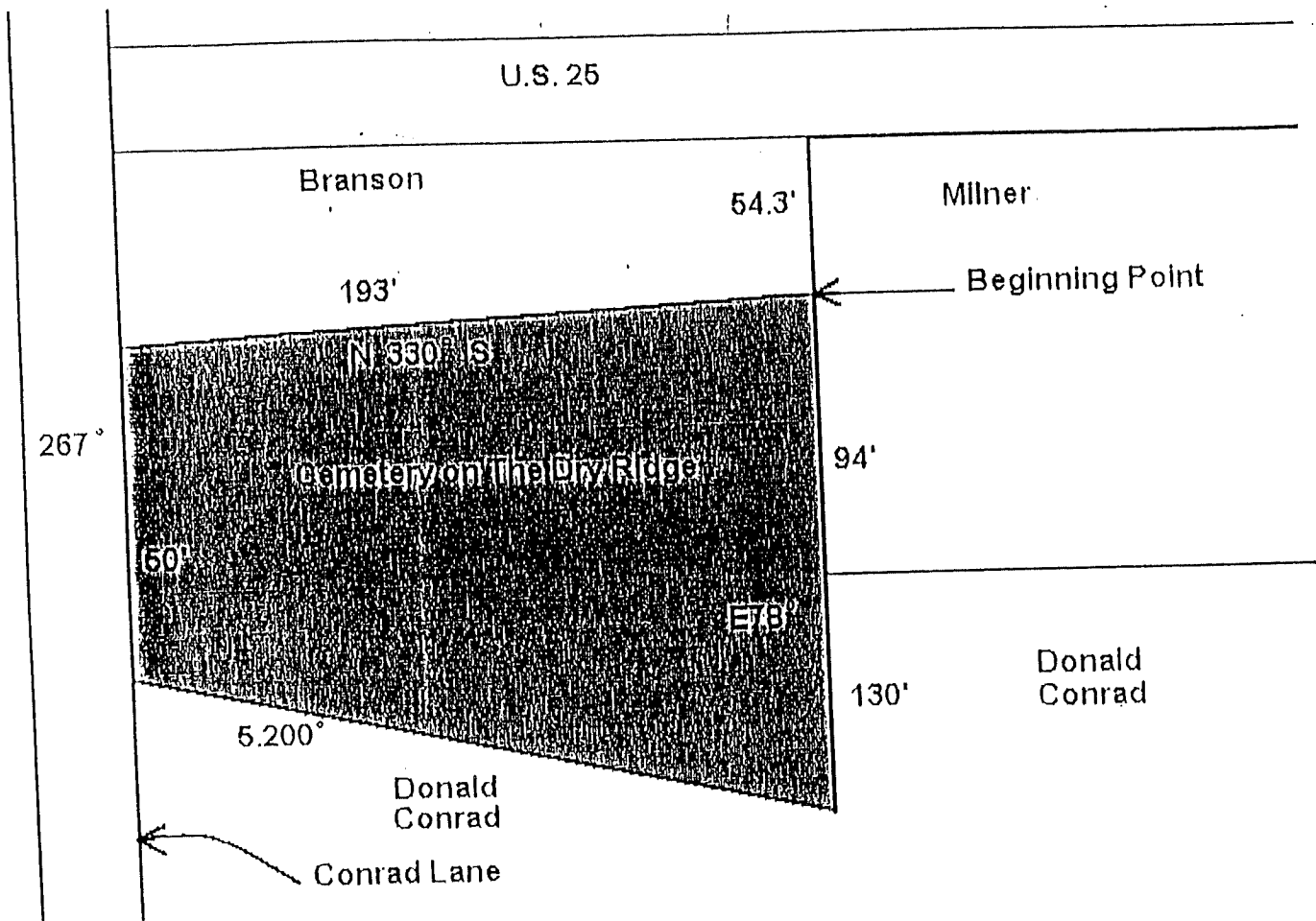
