Pursuant to K.R.S. 118.305 (7) and K.R.S. 83A.040(8), please be advised that on July 11, 1997 elected Mayor Robert Lee Jones was removed by impeachment on the basis of misconduct and willful neglect in the performance of his office by unanimous vote of the members of the Williamstown City Council. For your review and records is Municipal Order No. 1997-16 that outlines the Findings of Fact and Conclusions reached by the Williamstown City Council after full evidentiary hearing pursuant to notice on July 9, 10, and 11, 1997 at the Williamstown City Hall, Williamstown, Kentucky. We are advising you that the legislative body hereby designates the Mayor's office to be vacant pursuant to the above referenced statute.

Furthermore, please be advised that at a Special Called Meeting of the Williamstown City Council on July 17, 1997 pursuant to K.R.S. 61.825 the City Council had discussion regarding the election and appointment of Mayor, City of Williamstown, Kentucky and to fill the vacancy created pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.040(9) and the impeachment of Robert L. Jones. After said discussion by the

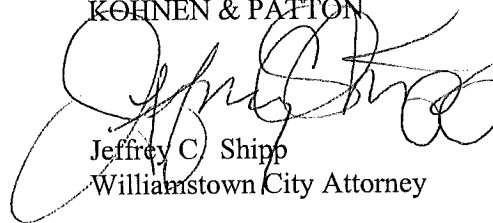

Council and Motion and Second, Councilman, Glenn Caldwell, Williamstown, Kentucky was appointed Mayor of the City of Williamstown, Kentucky. INSTRUCTION OF LAW WITH REGARD TO KRS 83A.040 (9)

Pursuant to Williamstown Ordinance 1997-13, special counsel hereby instructs the City Council of Williamstown with regard to the law of Kentucky as follows:

In 1980 the General Assembly of Kentucky enacted KRS 83A.040 (9), which states in part:

[A]ny elected officer, in case of misconduct, incapacity, or wilful neglect in the performance of the duties of his office, may be removed from office by a unanimous vote of the members of the legislative body. . .

The meaning of the terms "misconduct in office and wilful neglect of duty" had previously been addressed by Kentucky's highest court in the case of Kentucky State Board of Education v. Isenberg, 421 S.W.2d 81 (1967). In that opinion, the court stated:

But what is meant by "misconduct in office and/or wilful neglect of duty"? We may take one or all of the many definitions contained in the briefs for both appellant and appellees and come up with the same answer to this question. Briefly, "misconduct in office" means to conduct amiss; bad behavior. In Grover v. Stovall, 237 S.W.2d 24, 26 (1931), it was written:

"The word (misconduct in office) has a broad scope, and is more comprehensive than 'immoral conduct' or immorality,' since the acts composing them must necessarily be immoral in their nature. But conduct might not be intrinsically immoral and yet be 'misconduct' as growing out of the status and social relationship of the one engaged in it. According to the text in 40 C.J. 1220, it is defined as : 'Bad behavior; improper conduct; mismanagement; or wrong conduct, in usual parlance, a transgression of some established and definite rule of action, where no discretion is left, except what necessity may demand.'"

Misconduct and wilful neglect of duty are defined in 43 Am.Jur., Public Officers, Sec. 195, page 39, as follows: "[E]ither to maladministration or to wilful and intentional

neglect and failure to discharge the duties of the office * * * or to breach of good faith and right action.”

The term is thus defined in 67 C.J.S. Officers Sec. 60 (2) page 250: “[I]nvolving moral turpitude, or which is contrary to justice, honesty, principles, or good morals * * * breach of the good faith and right action.

While the General Assembly does not specifically define the term “misconduct, incapacity or wilful neglect of duty,” Kentucky’s law of statutory construction provides that if words or terms used in a statute have previously acquired an appropriate meaning in the law, those words or terms shall be construed and understood according to such meaning. Smith v. Board of Education of Ludlow, Ky, 94 S.W.2d 321 (1936).

In accordance with these provisions of law, the City Council of the City of Williamstown may remove Robert Lee Jones from office of Mayor of Williamstown, Kentucky pursuant to KRS 83A.040 (9) if council votes unanimously that Robert Lee Jones has engaged in at least one instance of “misconduct and/or wilful neglect of duty” according to the meaning of these terms under the law of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

REMOVING FROM OFFICE

MAYOR ROBERT LEE JONES (a/k/a Robert Hall Jones)

The City Council of the City of Williamstown, Kentucky, having reviewed the report of the investigation performed by special counsel pursuant to Ordinance 1997-13; having issued Municipal Order 1997-10 and Municipal Order 1997-14, Constituting 46 Articles of Impeachment and Resolution 1997-11; and having conducted a full evidentiary hearing on said Municipal Orders and in compliance with Resolution 1997-11, said hearing have been held, pursuant to prior notice, on July 9 - 11, 1997 at the Senior Center Room of Williamstown City Hall; does hereby order as follows:

SECTION 1 - FINDINGS OF FACT: Mayor **ROBERT LEE JONES (a/k/a ROBERT HALL JONES)** is found to have engaged in misconduct, and/or willful neglect in the performance of the duties of Mayor of the City of Williamstown, as provided in K.R.S. 83A.040(9) and Williamstown Code of Ordinances Title III, Chapter 30, Sec. 30.11, and in accordance with the law of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, as follows:

I. Mayor **ROBERT LEE JONES** has intentionally and without just cause harassed and retaliated against former Williamstown Chief of Police **PHIL HARNEY** (the chief):

- ~~A. by accusing the chief of sexual misconduct without proper grounds;~~
- B. by screaming and yelling at the chief; by on July 21, 1995 picking up the new cruiser properly ordered by the chief and using the vehicle for his personal use;
- C. by delegating the chief's duties and authority to the assistant chief regarding equipping said cruiser on August 11, 1995;
- D. by placing the chief on midnight shift the day after the chief's son, State Police Detective **RUSTY HARNEY**, found marijuana plants growing within a few feet of the mayor's son's home;
- E. by usurping the authority of the chief to schedule the police officers and the chief;
- ~~F. by authorizing ten hours of overtime to ASSISTANT CHIEF WEBB for the week ending September 1, 1995;~~
- G. by refusing to schedule the chief for regular work, thereby preventing the chief from working 40 hours in the week ending September 1, 1995;
- ~~H. by authorizing 27 hours of overtime to Officer CHRIS HANKINS for the week ending September 1, 1995.~~
