This cause coming on to be heard on the motion of the plaintiffs herein for a Summary Judgment, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that there is no genuine issue as to any material fact which would render valid or effective the annexation ordinance of the defendant City of Woodland Hills protested by plaintiffs in their Complaint, as amended, because said annexation ordinance annexes the incorporated territories and boundaries of the City of Douglas Hills No. 1, a sixth class Kentucky municipality, contrary to the provisions of Kentucky Revised Statutes and law, and the Court having heard arguments of counsel and being sufficiently advised, IT IS NOW ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Ordinance of the defendant, City of Woodland Hills, dated on or about August 28, 1973, which seeks to annex certain territories to the said city as described in this action, is adjudged void and invalid by reason of having included within said Ordinance a description of property containing the incorporated territory of the City of Douglas Hills No. 1, a sixth class city being a Kentucky municipality, contrary to the provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

2. This is a final judgment and there is no just cause for delay.
